**(CLASS DESCRIPTIONS ON BACK)
CLASS DESCRIPTIONS**

& Crafts (**K-2**) Students will work on different age appropriate arts & crafts.

Cookin' For Kids (**4-6**) Students will learn basic skills of cooking, prepare a food, and create a cookbook. **This class is NOT for those with food allergies.**

Drawing & Cartooning (**2&3**) – This class will introduce basic skills of drawing and cartooning.

Drawing & Cartooning (**4-8**) – This class will introduce more advance skills.

Fun with Fibers (**2&3**) – **This is a very hands on class.** Students will learn spinning and felting wool to conclude with various projects. They will learn knitting and work with various looms to produce a project.

Fun with Fibers (**4-6**) – Same as above.

*Gymnastics (**K-5**)* Floor exercises such as cartwheels, rolls, flips, and more will be practiced. **LOOSE clothes and SNEAKERS** are a must (**No sandals or bare feet**). **A routine set to music will be presented to parents on the last day.** Students are in various groups according to grade entering.

Listen & Learn (**K&1**) Designed to enhance listening, oral, and reading skills, **this class combines storytelling with a craft** project to make learning fun.

Science Kids (**K-2**) Students will participate in simple experiments and do some nature studies.

*Tae Kwon Do (**K-2**)* - Students will learn the basic art of self-defense. **Wear LOOSE clothes.**

*Tae Kwon Do (**3-8**)* – Same as above

World of Science (**3-6**) – This hands on program will be exploring the human skeleton, catapults, static electricity, magnetism, nature, plant growth, and simple (safe) chemical reactions. This will open a world they didn't know existed.

*Beginning Spanish (**1-3**)* – Students will learn basic Spanish words, numbers, and games.

*Beginning French (**2-4**)* Students will learn basic French words, numbers, and games.

*Introduction to Sign Language (**3-6**)* – Students will learn basic signs, phrases, and songs.
